COUNT I

HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, as Prosecuting Attorney for the State of Florida in the County of Broward, by and through his undersigned Assistant State Attorney, charges that **between November 13, 2018 and December 31, 2018**, in the County and State aforesaid, the defendant, **Jeffrey Stewart**, did then and there unlawfully and knowingly obtain or endeavor to obtain the property of **Maria Orellana-Cruz and St. David Catholic School Taylor Lee Scholarship**, to-wit: charity proceeds of the value of \$750.00 or more, but less than \$5,000.00, with the intent to either temporarily or permanently deprive **Maria Orellana-Cruz and St. David Catholic School Taylor Lee Scholarship** of the right to the property or a benefit from the property, or to appropriate the property to his own use or the use of any person not entitled to the use of the property, contrary to F.S. 812.014(1)(a), F.S. 812.014(1)(b) and F.S. 812.014(2)(c), (L3).
